Actual General Fund receipts for June 1, 2025, through November 30, 2025, total approximately \$365,000 compared to budgeted receipts of \$354,400, which is a \$10,600 surplus to budget. Actual expenses for the same period total approximately \$329,800, a cash surplus versus collections of \$35,200.

As of November 30th, the Christian Education Fund obligation for the 2025-2026 academic year is \$86,000.
